

TAMAGAWA RELIEF FUND

JUSTEC is establishing a charitable fund to support Tamagawa University's relief efforts on behalf of the children and families displaced by the devastating earthquake in North-East Japan.

In June, ten children, in grades 1 to 8, whose school was destroyed in Miyagi, came to Tamagawa to complete the spring semester. They lived in the homes of Tamagawa faculty and received free education at Tamagawa. The faculty and staff at Tamagawa contributed generously to assist with transportation for the children and their families, to and from Tokyo, and to help provide clothing and school-related materials. In September, a second group of children will come to Tamagawa from the area hit hardest by the storm.

Funds are needed to support this effort, especially to assist with transportation costs for the children and families so that they may visit each other for a few times during this period away from home.
